# ADMISSION INFORMATION

## PRE-K3 & K4

Before a child will be considered for admission to St. Paul Catholic School, all applications must be complete. The following documentation must be submitted:

- Completed Application for Admission
- Copy of birth certificate

### **Admission priority will be as follows:**

1. Siblings of enrolled students and children of teachers dependent on available classroom space;
2. Children of registered, contributing and participating members of St. Paul Catholic Parish based on length of time in the parish;
3. Children of families registered in another Catholic parish;
4. Non-Catholics who qualify and agree to conform to the school's religious instruction and policies.

### **Notification of Acceptance**

Acceptance letters will be mailed after all the required admission documents are received and reviewed. If a child qualifies for admission to SPCS, but there is no opening in the grade for which the child is applying, s/he will be put on a waiting list on a first-come, first-serve basis. All new students will be on probation academically and behaviorally for the first quarter following their admission. Students must be fully potty trained and should be emotionally and socially ready to begin school.

### **Pre-K3**

This program is a curriculum based program. We offer a 5, 3 and 2 day program 7:45 a.m. – 2:45 p.m. Students entering this academic program must be three years old by September 1, 2017.

### **Pre-K4**

This program is a curriculum based program. The program hours are full day; 7:45 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. Students entering this academic program must be four years old by September 1, 2017.

### **VPK4 with Extended Pre-K4 Program**

This program includes VPK and an extended PreK curriculum program. The program hours are full day; 7:45 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. Students entering this academic program must be born between September 2, 2012 and September 1, 2013.

### **VPK4 Only Programs**

A VPK-Only option is available with hours from 7:45 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Students entering this academic program must be born between September 2, 2012 and September 1, 2013. Information from the Early Learning Coalition will be provided in April.
