



# TUITION AND FEES 2017 – 2018

Tuition Payment plans (**12-month schedule**) begin June, 2017 through May, 2018.

## **K3-8 Registration Fee (Non-Refundable):** due at the time of registration

Returning Students .....	\$ 125 per child
New Students .....	\$ 175 per child

## **K3 Preschool Program Tuition:**

2 days a week .....	\$ 2,520
3 days a week .....	\$ 3,780
5 days a week .....	\$ 6,300 *
*K3 – 5 days a week program can apply for sibling discount of \$800	

## **K4 Preschool Program (5 days a week) Tuition:**

VPK with extended full day program per student .....	\$ 3,675
Non VPK full day program per student .....	\$ 6,300 *
*K4 – 5 days a week program <i>non-VPK</i> can apply for sibling discount of \$800	

## **St. Paul Parishioners: K-8 Tuition WITH Parish Grant\*:**

One Child .....	\$ 5,470
Two Children .....	\$ 9,485
Three Children .....	\$ 13,438

### **\*To qualify for Parish Grant you must be registered in a Catholic parish:**

St. Paul Parishioners must submit a "Stewardship Commitment Card" annually, each of the three components of stewardship – time, talent and treasure – must be fulfilled to receive our parish school tuition subsidy:

- Make a commitment to spend time with God in prayer.
- Commit or recommit to at least one of St. Paul's many parish ministries.
- Make a commitment to give 5% or more of income to the parish offertory.

The Stewardship Committee will confirm with the school whether a St. Paul Parish school family has met all requirements to qualify for the Parish Grant. A letter of Acceptance or Denial will be included in the family's registration packet.

Families applying for a Parish Grant from a parish other than St. Paul must meet with your parish priest to go over his requirements. Return completed and signed Parish Participation Grant Form to the school office at the time of registration. Note: pastors reserve the right to revoke the subsidy if a family is not meeting the established obligations.
