ADMISSION INFORMATION KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 8

Before a child will be considered for admission to St. Paul Catholic School, all applications must be complete. The following documentation must be submitted:

- Completed Application for Admission
- Copy of birth certificate
- Copy of current report card (Students entering grades 1-8)
- Copy of most recent standardized test results (Students entering grades 1-8)
- IEP or 504 Plan if applicable

Admission priority will be as follows:

1. Siblings of enrolled students and children of teacher's dependent on available classroom space;
2. Children of registered, contributing and participating members of St. Paul Catholic Parish based on length of time in the parish;
3. Children of families registered in another Catholic parish;
4. Non-Catholics who qualify and agree to conform to the school's religious instruction and policies.

Notification of Acceptance

Acceptance letters will be mailed after all required admission documents have been received and reviewed. If a child qualifies for admission to SPCS, but there is no opening in the grade for which the child is applying, s/he will be put on a waiting list on a first-come, first-serve basis. All new students will be on probation academically and behaviorally for the first quarter following their admission.

Kindergarten

Students entering Kindergarten must be five years old by September 1, 2018.
