Admission Information



Before a child will be considered for admission to St. Paul Catholic School, all applications must be complete. The following documentation must be submitted:

- Completed Application for Admission
- Copy of birth certificate (Students entering Pre-K or Kindergarten)
- Copy of current report card (Students entering grades 1-8)
- Copy of most recent standardized test results (Students entering grades 1-8)
- IEP or 504 Plan if applicable

Admission priority will be as follows:

1. Currently enrolled students who have met the previous year's financial obligations;
2. Siblings of enrolled students and children of teachers dependent on available classroom space;
3. Children of registered, contributing and participating members of St. Paul Catholic Parish based on length of time in the parish;
4. Children of families registered in another Catholic parish;
5. Non-Catholics who qualify and agree to conform to the school's religious instruction and policies.

Notification of Acceptance

Acceptance letters are mailed the end of February. If a child qualifies for admission to SPCS, but there is no opening in the grade for which the child is applying, s/he will be put on a waiting list on a first-come, first-serve basis. All new students will be on probation academically and behaviorally for the first quarter following their admission.

PreK and VPK-Only Programs

Students entering this academic program must be four years old by September 1. PreK program hours are full day; 7:45am to 2:45pm. A VPK-Only option is available with hours from 7:45am to 11:30am. Information from the Early Learning Coalition will be provided in April.

Students entering Kindergarten must be five years old by September 1.
