Pre-registration is not necessary. Students may be dropped off on a day-by- day/need basis. We will have a checklist of all students' names and will ask them to sign in to keep track of those who use the service.

Invoices will be sent home to the parents monthly.

Students may be dropped off between 7:00- 7:29 a.m. and should enter through the main door. Mrs. Manning will be there to meet them.

Cost is \$5.00/day per child.

Please note: Any student who is not a scheduled safety patrol worker for the day and is dropped off or arrives by bike before 7:30 will be sent to Before School Care and the parents will be charged the \$5.00 per child for the day. This is the only way we can ensure that they have adequate supervision.
