

1st Grade Summer Reading

Research has shown that the single greatest factor in predicting reading success, is whether a child is read to when they are young. My goal for the summer, is to have you read with your child as often as possible.

Your child will have one written reading assignment. Students should select one book at their level. They will write two sentences about the book and illustrate their favorite part.

What are sight words?

Included in this packet, is the Pre-Primer and Primer sight words. We will test on these words the week of August 13th.

Sight Word

Sight words are the most common words found in text. Students should be able to read sight words automatically and on demand. Unlike phonic words, we do not ask students to sound out or blend sight words. Successful readers are able to recognize these words "on sight".


12 sight words make up 25% of those we read and write. 100 sight words make up 50% of those we read and write. About 300 sight words account for 75% of those we read and write

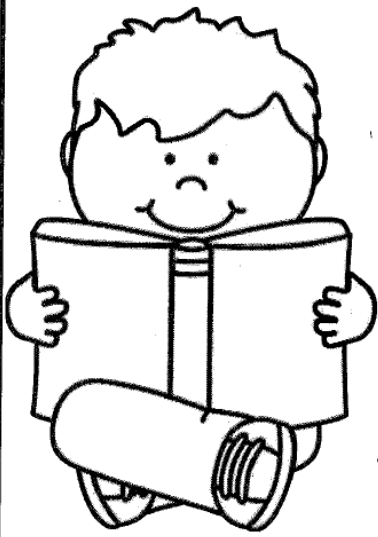

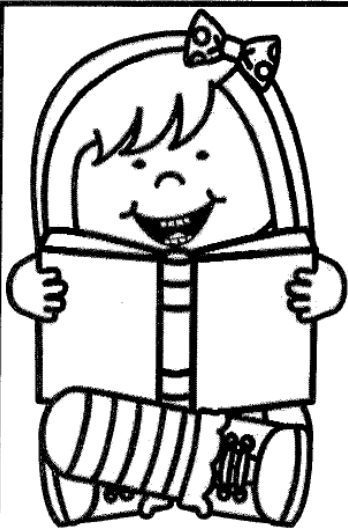

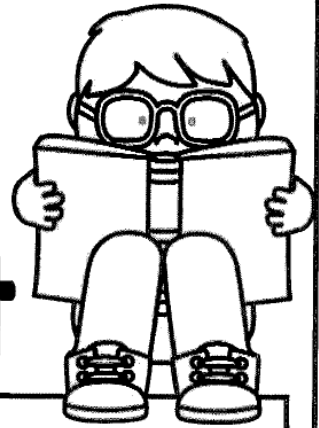
