Dear school administrator,

The deadline for NEW applicants to submit an application for the 2015-16 school year for the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship is Friday, May 15, 2015 at 5 pm Eastern. Please encourage families new to the program to login at www.stepupforstudents.org and submit their application by clicking the "Finish Application" button at the end of the online application.

Additionally, any families that have submitted an application parents must submit documents via fax or document by Friday, May 29th at 5 pm Eastern.

Failure to adhere to the above deadlines will result in the closure of scholarship applications and families will not be eligible to receive funds for the 2015-16 school year. Additionally, the later parents wait to submit an application or supporting documents, the more likely that they'll be placed on a waiting list versus being awarded as applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Exams will take place first thing in the morning and be completed by lunch. The afternoons will consist of review sessions for the remaining exams and various classes.

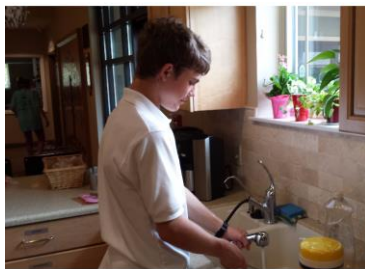
Please make sure your child has begun studying for these exams! A good night's sleep and healthy breakfast during exam week are also key elements in a successful outcome!
